

Williams Fire Department Burn Permit Application

The following provisions must be met and understood by the person responsible for burning.

- 1. Prior to any burning, contact the Williams Fire Marshal at 928-635-4451 to verify that no burn restrictions are in place. (Burn hours: 8am to 3pm)
- 2. Notify the Williams Police Department 928-635-4461 and Kaibab National Forest Dispatch 928-635-2601 in advance of burning. These dispatch centers do not authorize burning. Permission is only obtained from the fire official.
- 3. The area to be burned MUST be inspected by the Williams Fire Department PRIOR to any burning (Only necessary on the first burn, if burning more than one date).
- 4. An adequate water source and delivery system must be present at all times while burning is being conducted.
- 5. The landowner or their designated representative must be present at all times while burning is being conducted.
- 6. Only organic material may be burned. (Untreaded wood, brush, grass, etc.) No paper or plastics.
- 7. No more than 50 cubic yards (14' x 14' x 7') of materials will be burned in a single pile.
- 8. An area of 10 feet around the burn will be cleared to mineral soil prior to ignition.
- 9. All burning will be completely extinguished before abandoning the site.
- 10. No burning will be done when winds exceed 10 M.P.H.
- 11. A letter of authorization from the landowner must be presented to the City of Williams before a permit will be issued (if other than the landowner is doing the burning).
- 12. The landowner is responsible for any damage caused by the burning.
- 13. The landowner will pay for any and all costs incurred in suppressing the control burn or any fires caused from the burning.
- 14. The burn permit must be in possession of the person conducting the burn.
- 15. The permit is subject to revocation if burning conditions, rules and stipulations are not met.
