SANITATION EQUIPMENT OPERATOR I

City of Williams Position Description (Grade 6)

Summary of Position

Collects garbage, trash, recyclable and street wastes through the operation and minor maintenance of an automated waste disposal truck; operates tractor/trailer rig to haul trash or recyclable material to designated sites

Organizational Relationships

1. Reports to: Sanitation Superintendent or Foreman
2. Directs: This is a non-supervisory position
3. Other: May involve exposure to adverse weather conditions, and disagreeable and potentially unsafe materials.

Essential Duties

- Drives designated trash collection routes, collects trash and delivers to waste disposal site.
- Drives designated recycle collection routes, collects recyclable materials and delivers to designated site.
- Picks up loose trash, manually collects miscellaneous garbage, trash and street wastes as required.
- May be called upon to perform a variety of construction, maintenance and repair activities in the public works program, including emergency work and/or snow removal

Job Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

- High School Diploma or GED
- Possession of current, valid CDL – Class A or Class B
- Knowledge of hazards and applicable safety rules and precautions in equipment operation.
- Skill in operating equipment efficiently and safely.
- Ability to understand and carry out oral and written instructions and to work independently and in isolation in the performance of regular duties.
- Ability to work in adverse weather conditions at a high altitude, exposed to outside elements, disagreeable materials, and potentially unsafe materials
