Re: Electric System Deficiencies

Dear Building Permit Applicant and Valued Electric Service Customer,

The City of Williams has recently been informed by our consultant and electric system operator, APS, that there are major concerns about the availability of electrical services on our system. They have recommended that building permits, requiring a new or upgraded service, not be issued at this time, until availability had been confirmed.

The City of Williams has authorized APS to conduct a study to determine the available electricity, as well as the current deficiencies, in our system. This study will allow us to determine where new services are allowed, and which areas will require infrastructure improvements to handle additional services.

Beginning immediately, the City of Williams will not be accepting any permit applications requiring a new electric service, or an upgrade on an existing service, until the areas of concern have been addressed. A study of the complete electric system should be concluded within thirty (30) to sixty (60) days.

We are confident that this electrical issue will be resolved. If you have building plans and financing that are time sensitive please contact Tim Pettit, Chief Building Inspector.
