

***I. PROCEDURES***

- A. Call to Order Vice-Chairperson Jim Bultema called the meeting to order at 10:01.
- B. Pledge of Allegiance Vice-Chairperson Jim Bultema led the Pledge.
- C. Roll Call Vice-Chairperson Jim Bultema, Commissioners Al Dunaway, Andrea Dunn, Norma McDowell and Mike Besler were present. Present from City Staff were Tim Pettit, City Building Inspector and Pamela Galvan, Administrative Assistant.
- D. Approval of minutes for June 10 and June 17, 2014 Commissioner McDowell made a motion to approve the minutes. Commissioner Dunaway seconded the motion, and it carried 5-0.
- E. Adopt Agenda Commissioner Dunaway made a motion to approve the Agenda, Commissioner McDowell seconded the motion, and it carried 5-0.

***AGENDA ITEMS***

- A. Commission will discuss and may decide on a request to place a table, two chairs and two flower pots on the sidewalk in front of the Canyon Club at 132 W. Route 66. (*Teresa Stevens*) Vice-Chairperson Bultema read item A. to the Commission and invited Teresa Stevens to address the Commission. Rebel Grimm represented Teresa and explained that they would like to put out a table, two chairs and two flower pots.
- Commissioner Dunn noted that she had seen them out there already and felt they were intimidating to passersby.
- Ms. Grimm said they will be bringing them (table and chairs) in each night. They will have the bartender manage the guests that tend to linger outside at the table.
- It was expressed that we do not want groups hanging out blocking the sidewalk, and Rebel again said they would have the bartender manage this.
- Commission Besler asked Tim Pettit if there were any regulations on the number of benches, tables, etc., that a business can place in front of their business. Tim said there is none.
- Commissioner McDowell made a motion to approve the request for a table, two chairs and two flower pots at the Canyon Club. Commissioner Besler seconded the motion, and it carried 5-0.
- B. Commission will discuss and may decide on a request for projecting sign on an existing frame for Open Road Cowboy at 246 W. Route Vice-Chairperson Bultema read item B. to the Commission and invited Jay Redfeather to come forward to present his request.
- Mr. Redfeather explained that the sign is already done and ready to hang. It is a four by four sign, and it hangs nine feet above the sidewalk. There is existing lighting, but he cannot locate the switch. He does not intend to use the existing lighting, because he prefers the lighting from the street lamp.
- Commissioner Besler made a motion to accept the sign request for Open

66: (Jay Redfeather) Road Cowboy. Commissioner Dunaway seconded the motion, and it carried, 5-0.
