BURN PERMIT

_____ is authorized to control burn in the Corporate Limits of Williams, Arizona. The location of the burn is at or near _____ (street address or geographic location) during the period from _____, 20__ to _____, 20__. The following provisions must be met and understood by the person responsible for the burning.

1. **PRIOR** to any burning, contact the Williams Fire Marshall at (635-4451) to make sure that it is still okay to burn. (This should be done weekly to ensure that no restrictions have been ordered).
2. The area to be burned **MUST** be inspected by the Williams Fire Department **PRIOR** to any burning (Only necessary on the first burn, if burning on more than one date).
3. An adequate water source and delivery system must be present and in working order during the burning.
4. The landowner or his designated representative must be present at all times while burning is being conducted.
5. Only organic material may be burned. (Untreated wood, brush, grass, etc.) No paper or plastics.
6. No more than 50 cubic yards (14' x 14' x 7') of material will be burned in a single pile.
7. An area of 10 (ten) feet around the burn will be cleared to mineral soil before ignition.
8. All burning will be completely extinguished before abandoning the site.
9. No burning will be done when winds exceed 10 M.P.H.
10. A letter of Authorization from the landowner must be presented to the City of Williams, before a burning permit is issued (if other than the landowner is doing the burning).
11. The landowner is responsible for any damage caused by the burning.
12. The landowner will pay for any and all costs incurred in suppressing the control burn or any fires caused from the burning.
13. The burn permit **MUST** be in possession of the person conducting the burn.
14. The Williams Police Department (635-4461) and the Kaibab National Forest Dispatch (635-2601) **MUST be notified** in advance of burning. (They **do not** give the Permittee permission to burn! Permission is only obtained from the Williams Fire Marshall or Williams Fire Chief)
15. The permit is subject to revocation if burning conditions, rules and stipulations are not met.
