Discussion of the 2-5 year Plan for the Recreation Center: Sylvia briefed the Committee on her plans for updating the Recreation center, discussed her new computer system for more activities.

Sylvia discussed her plans to improve the Recreation Center, Shed and pool:

Recreation Center:

Knock off the back of the rec center old storage area and rebuild new storage for table and chairs. Bring back Movie Night. Stereo System installed, paint lines on outside basketball court, include more family events, bingo, game night, Pizza parties.

In the next 5 years use the east side of outside shed to put an activity course in that area. Update playground. Continue making the Rec Center enjoyable for the kids.

Shed: Game area in the shed, host more activities in the shed (Martial Arts, gymnastic). Add new seating and stereo system in shed, new Lu System. Chairman Williams asked if there was any chance of putting in a better bathroom, Troy stated that this cannot be done due to the location, but when Sylvia obtain more storage, a lot of the materials in the current bathroom can be removed, allowing more space in the bathroom

Pool: New Diving blocks, get more items for the pool use. Host more swim activities, resurface the bottom of the pool, have a junior life guard class. Committees asked if anyone uses the diving blocks, and why have them if no diving is allowed. Sylvia mentioned that they are used when the swimmers push off while swimming in the pool.

In the next 5 years fix the rusting in the building, life guard chairs and Aqua Zip line.
